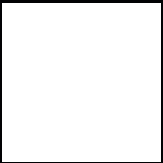

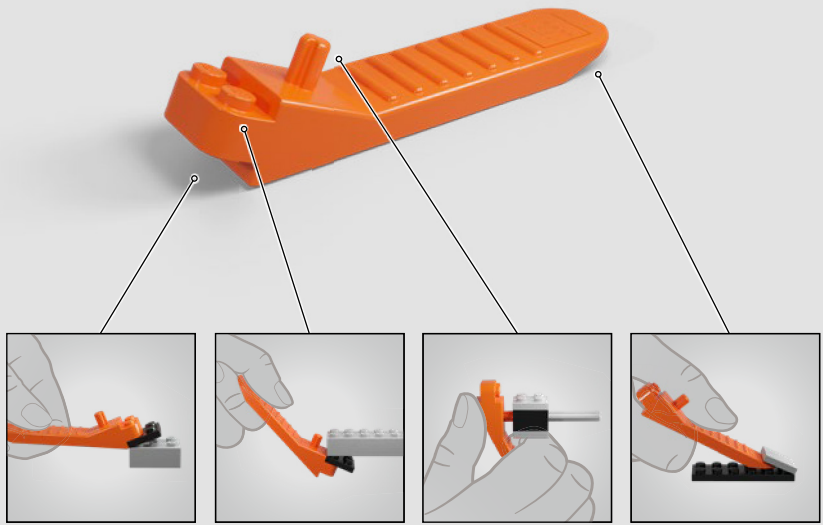

A beacon of safety

For as long as humans have traveled the seven seas, safe navigation has been vital to explorers and travelers, fishermen and merchants, navies and blue-water sailors. Stone arrangements, bonfires, cressets or braziers were used as coastal landmarks to help seafarers steer clear of perils, day and night.

The earliest known stone lighthouse that resembled the structures we know today, the Lighthouse of Alexandria, was built in Egypt over 2,000 years ago. Until the early 1900s, lighthouse keepers would live in accommodations on the property and be available around the clock to keep candles, coal, sperm whale oil, kerosene, paraffin, or gas flames burning.

Each lighthouse is unique, with signature colors or features to make them easily recognizable in daylight, too. As landmarks in the geographical sense, and in technological advances, these beacons continue to keep sailors safe. Additional safety equipment like foghorns and the electronic Automatic Identification System (AIS) are now standard in most lighthouses, and most are fully automated and maintained by official agencies.


With more than 23,500 lighthouses covering 372,000 miles (598,675.5 kilometers) of coastline around the world, they represent part of our collective history, adventure and the promise of safe havens in a stormy sea.



Un signal essentiel

Depuis que l'homme sillonne les sept mers, il est vital pour les explorateurs et les voyageurs, les pêcheurs et les marchands, les forces navales et les marins de haute mer de naviguer en toute sécurité. Des agencements de pierres, des feux, des flambeaux ou des braseros étaient utilisés comme points de repère côtiers pour aider les navigateurs à contourner les obstacles, de jour comme de nuit.

Le plus ancien phare en pierre comparable aux structures que nous connaissons aujourd'hui, le phare d'Alexandrie, a été construit en Égypte il y a plus de 2 000 ans. Jusqu'au début des années 1900, les gardiens de phare vivaient dans des logements sur la propriété et travaillaient jour et nuit pour maintenir allumées les flammes de bougies, de charbon, d'huile de cachalot, de kérosène, de paraffine ou de gaz.

Chaque phare est unique et présente des couleurs ou des caractéristiques qui le rendent facilement reconnaissable en plein jour. Monuments géographiques et témoins des avancées technologiques, les phares continuent d'assurer la sécurité des marins. Des équipements de sécurité supplémentaires, tels que les cornes de brume et le système d'identification automatique (SIA), sont désormais la norme dans la plupart des phares, et la majorité d'entre eux sont entièrement automatisés et entretenus par des organismes officiels.

Avec plus de 23 500 phares couvrant 598 675,5 kilomètres de côtes à travers le monde, ils représentent une page de notre histoire collective, l'aventure et la promesse d'un sanctuaire dans une mer déchaînée.

Un símbolo de seguridad

Desde que el ser humano navega por los océanos, la seguridad en el mar ha sido fundamental para exploradores y viajeros, pescadores y comerciantes, armadas y marineros de alta mar. Instalaciones de piedra, fogatas, pebeteros y candiles han servido a lo largo de la historia como puntos de referencia en la costa para ayudar a los navegantes a evitar el peligro, tanto de día como de noche.

El primer faro de piedra del que hay registro y que se asemeja a las estructuras que conocemos hoy, el Faro de Alejandría, se construyó en Egipto hace más de 2000 años. Hasta principios del siglo XX, los fareros vivían en los alojamientos del edificio y debían estar disponibles a todas horas para mantener prendidas las velas, el carbón, el aceite de ballena, el queroseno, la parafina o el gas, y evitar que las llamas se apagaran.

No hay dos faros iguales y todos ellos cuentan con colores o rasgos característicos que los hacen fácilmente reconocibles también a plena luz del día. Como puntos de referencia en un sentido geográfico, y gracias a los avances tecnológicos, estas señales luminosas siguen velando por la seguridad de los marinos. En la actualidad, la mayoría de los faros cuentan con equipos de seguridad complementarios, como sirenas de niebla y sistemas electrónicos AIS (Automatic Identification System), están totalmente automatizados y son mantenidos por organismos oficiales.

Los más de 23.500 faros que vigilan 598.675,5 km de costa en todo el mundo forman parte indisoluble de nuestra historia colectiva, del espíritu de aventura y de la promesa de un refugio seguro en aguas tempestuosas.

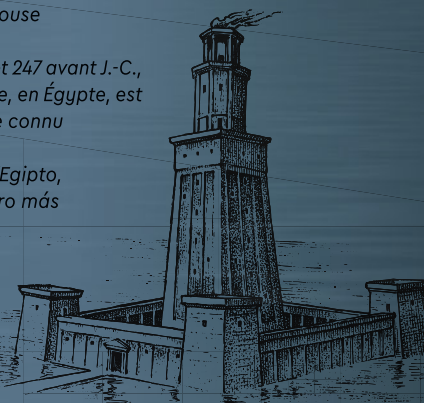

The Fresnel lens

Obviously, the further a lighthouse beacon can reach in the worst weather conditions, the better. During the 1600–1700s, mirrors, parabolic reflectors and Argand lamps created increasingly brighter beams. The Fresnel lens, invented in 1821, revolutionized the construction of lighthouses. Through layers of ring-shaped glass lenses, a light source could now be concentrated into a narrow beam, dramatically enhancing both the intensity and nominal range of light. This was likely the most significant development in lighthouse design until the introduction of electrical lights, and it is still in use today.

Fresnel lenses used in lighthouses are now often made of plastic, making them both lighter in use and cheaper to manufacture. With modern, automated rotation functions and electrical light sources, they can create powerful range and enhance visibility. Fresnel lenses are also used in floodlights, ship lanterns and even in cameras.

To recreate the characteristic rotating light function, the LEGO® Ideas design team developed a LEGO version of the Fresnel lens. A lot of research went into replicating the original engineering of the lens, followed by performance tests to achieve a smooth and authentic experience.

La lentille de Fresnel

Bien entendu, plus la portée du signal d'un phare est importante même dans les pires conditions météorologiques, mieux c'est. Au cours des années 1600 et 1700, les miroirs, les réflecteurs paraboliques et les lampes Argand ont permis de créer des faisceaux de plus en plus brillants. La lentille de Fresnel, inventée en 1821, a révolutionné la construction des phares. Grâce à cette lentille divisée en sections annulaires, une source de lumière peut désormais être concentrée en un faisceau étroit, ce qui améliore considérablement l'intensité et la portée nominale de la lumière. Jusqu'à l'introduction des lampes électriques, il s'agissait probablement de la plus importante innovation apportée aux phares, et elle est toujours utilisée aujourd'hui.

De nos jours, les lentilles de Fresnel utilisées dans les phares sont souvent en plastique, ce qui les rend à la fois plus légères et moins chères à fabriquer. Grâce à des fonctions de rotation modernes et automatisées et à des sources lumineuses électriques, elles peuvent atteindre une portée considérable et améliorer la visibilité. Les lentilles de Fresnel sont également utilisées dans les projecteurs, les lanternes de bateaux et même dans les appareils photo.

Pour recréer la lumière rotative caractéristique, l'équipe de conception de LEGO® Ideas a développé une version LEGO de la lentille de Fresnel. De nombreuses recherches ont été menées pour reproduire l'ingénierie originale de la lentille, puis des tests de performance ont été effectués pour garantir une expérience fluide et authentique.

El lente de Fresnel

Obviamente, cuanto más lejos pueda llegar la luz de un faro en las peores condiciones climáticas, mejor. En los siglos XVII y XVIII se crearon espejos, reflectores parabólicos y quinqués para incrementar la intensidad del haz de luz. El lente de Fresnel, inventado en 1821, revolucionó la construcción de los faros. Mediante lentes de vidrio anulares organizados en capas, ahora era posible concentrar una fuente de luz en un haz estrecho que mejoraba tanto la intensidad como el alcance nominal de la luz. Probablemente, este fue el avance más importante del diseño de los faros hasta la introducción de la luz eléctrica, y todavía hoy se utiliza.

Los lentes de Fresnel que usan los faros en la actualidad suelen ser de plástico, lo que los hace más ligeros y baratas de fabricar. Junto con modernas funciones de rotación automatizada y fuentes de luz eléctricas, permiten obtener un gran alcance y, al mismo tiempo, mejoran la visibilidad. Los lentes de Fresnel también se emplean en focos, señales náuticas e incluso cámaras fotográficas.

Para recrear la característica función de rotación de la luz, el equipo de diseño de LEGO® Ideas desarrolló una versión LEGO del lente de Fresnel. Se investigó mucho para replicar la ingeniería original del lente y se llevaron a cabo pruebas de desempeño para lograr una experiencia sencilla y auténtica.

Meet the Fan Designer

Sandro Quattrini (LEGO® Ideas name: Roses Must Build) is a 20-year-old film animation student from Canada. When not busy at university, he spends time with friends, or rearranges his LEGO collection, very often into new builds.

"I've been building LEGO sets since I was five years old. It's a way to unplug and relax. I love building tall structures. My mother loves lighthouses and has been telling me to build one ever since we took a trip around the Gaspésie Peninsula (Quebec) years ago. We visited enormous stone lighthouses on rocky beaches and small, abandoned wooden ones. From titanic structures that tower over their towns to cozy little

houses that sit calmly far away from civilization, where all you hear is the sound of waves crashing against rocks. That's the essence I wanted to capture, and their solitary nature.

I built the lantern room first, then two sides of the tower and only then did I think of adding the turning-light mechanism! Everything took time and trial-and-error, and my limited selection of bricks forced me to be creative with shapes and techniques. It's a challenging and rewarding experience. It was a huge surprise when it reached 10,000 supporters. I didn't realize it had been featured on LEGO fan websites and blogs. I am so thankful for everyone's support. Enjoy building!"

Rencontre avec le concepteur amateur

Sandro Quattrini (pseudonyme LEGO® Ideas : Roses Must Build) est un étudiant canadien en animation cinématographique de 20 ans. En dehors de ses études universitaires, il passe du temps avec ses amis ou remanie sa collection LEGO, très souvent pour créer de nouvelles constructions.

« Je construis des ensembles LEGO depuis que j'ai cinq ans. C'est un bon moyen de se déconnecter et de se détendre. J'adore construire de grandes structures. Ma mère adore les phares et me demande d'en construire un depuis que nous avons visité la péninsule gaspésienne (au Québec) il y a quelques années. Nous avons visité d'énormes phares en pierre sur des plages rocheuses et de petits phares en bois abandonnés. Des structures titanesques qui surplombent leurs villes aux petites maisons douillettes isolées de la civilisation, où l'on n'entend que le bruit des vagues qui se fracassent contre les rochers. Je n'avais pas réalisé qu'il avait été présenté sur des sites et des blogs d'amateurs de LEGO. Je vous remercie infiniment pour votre soutien. Bonne construction ! »

Sandro Quattrini (conocido en LEGO® Ideas como Roses Must Build) tiene 20 años y estudia animación cinematográfica en Canadá. Cuando no está ocupado en la universidad, le gusta pasar tiempo con sus amigos y reestructurando su colección LEGO, lo que, muy frecuentemente, da lugar a nuevos modelos.

Me sorprendió muchísimo llegar a los 10.000 votos. No sabía que había salido en sitios web y blogs de fans de LEGO. Estoy muy agradecido por el apoyo que recibí de todo el mundo. ¡Disfruten construyendo!"
